The entrance examination takes place **in January**.

The entrance examination takes place in June.
Period of study at the Studienkolleg:
Early September – mid of February

How much will it cost?

Each semester, an administration fee will incur (i.e. 2013: 252,20 €/semester) as well as an all inclusive examination fee of 100 €. The fee includes a semester ticket for public transport of the Rhine-Main region (RMV)
